About the Campus Leader Program

[Teach For Pakistan's](#) Campus Leader Program embodies our core belief that the development of our future leaders will ultimately shape our own future; the future of Pakistan. This six-month experience is a unique opportunity for students to join the Teach For Pakistan movement for educational equity so that one day, all of Pakistan's children have an education that enables them to become loving, thinking, and engaged citizens.

Campus Leaders primarily operate in two domains: education advocacy and recruitment support. They play a vital role in mobilizing their peers, raising awareness, and driving meaningful initiatives that address the educational inequity present in our society. Teach For Pakistan's Campus Leaders not only develop their own leadership skills but also ensure that Pakistan's most outstanding talent is taking charge of one of this country's most critical issues.

Who we are

Teach For Pakistan is a nationwide movement of outstanding graduates and young professionals who commit two years to teach in under-resourced schools, and go on to become lifelong leaders working across all fields to expand educational opportunities.

After the Fellowship, our Alumni use their experiences to tackle Pakistan's most pressing problems in education, fostering action to change policy and curriculum, mobilizing resources, turning around schools, and spurring social innovation. Collectively, this movement aims to transform systems of educational inequity and promote excellence in education. Teach For Pakistan is a partner in the [Teach For All](#) global network of 60+ independent, national organizations working to expand educational outcomes for children all over the world.

What the role entails

- Design and execute an education advocacy campaign on your campus to deepen the understanding of education inequity in Pakistan and spearhead the movement towards equitable education on your campus
- Manage relationships with key stakeholders on campus to strengthen the dialogue about the educational crisis in Pakistan
- Support the recruitment team in sourcing the best leadership potential for the Teach For Pakistan Fellowship by connecting it to interested and high-potential candidates
- Support the recruitment team during activities on campus

Who we look for

An applicant must:

- Be passionate about equity in education in Pakistan, and care deeply about the future of Pakistan's children;
- Be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program in the required university
- Have demonstrated excellence in a leadership role in their professional, academic, or co-curricular experiences;
- Possess strong critical thinking, problem-solving, and project management skills;
- Be able to communicate effectively with various stakeholders, and mobilize them to work collaboratively for a shared cause

- An opportunity to learn from the Teach For Pakistan recruitment team and become a part of the community;
- A chance to build your project management skills by designing and executing an advocacy campaign and presenting your project to a panel of distinguished professionals for feedback;
- Funding to run a campus-wide education advocacy campaign
- Workshops to develop and strengthen Campus Leaders' professional skills;
- A chance to qualify for the penultimate stage of selection for the Teach For Pakistan Fellowship;
- A chance to be recommended for the Teach For Pakistan Summer Internship Program in 2026;
